Voilà Québec! is a 7 night camp held at Québec's provincial camp Wa-Thik-Ane, the camp of peaceful waters.

Girls will experience Québec culture, language, and heritage in an intimate community camp with under 120 Guiding sisters. Girls will complete program work and a special camp challenge.

Adventure awaits with two outings: St. Sauveur water park (largest in Québec) and a day trip to Mont Tremblant village and a tree adventure course.

Voilà Québec is open to 3rd year Guides, Pathfinders, and Rangers (girls born in 2006 or earlier) from across Canada and the United States.

Camp Wa-Thik-Ane

Opened in 1926, Wa-Thik-Ane is located an hour north of Montréal, situated on Lac Bouchette.

Cost

\$550 CAD per person (tax incld.)

Included: Montreal area pick up/drop off, lodging, food, programming, out trips, badges, and crests

Not included: transportation to and from Montréal, insurance, personal expenses, and optional pre/post camp activities.
